1. Introduction

2. What Are Cookies

Cookies are small text files stored on your device to enable functionality, security, analytics, and marketing.

We may use third-party providers including:

- CRM and marketing automation tools
- Trading platform providers (e.g., CloudTrade environments where applicable)

These providers may process data in accordance with their own privacy policies.

5. Legal Basis (GDPR/UK GDPR)

- Strictly Necessary Cookies: processed under legitimate interest.
- Analytics, Functional, and Marketing Cookies: processed based on user consent.

6. Managing Cookies

You can manage cookies via:

- Cookie consent banner
- Browser settings (e.g., blocking or deleting cookies)

Please note that disabling certain cookies may impact functionality of the Services.

7. Retention

- Session cookies: deleted when you close your browser.
- Persistent cookies: retained for the period specified in the table above or until manually deleted.

10. Additional Information

10.1 Cookie & Tracker Inventory (Expanded)

In addition to the table above, we maintain an internal register of all cookies and tracking technologies deployed across:

- Website domains
- Client portal

This inventory includes:

- Full technical identifiers
- Data flows (collection → storage → transfer)
- Third-country transfer mapping
- Vendor contracts and DPAs

This register is reviewed periodically and updated upon any material change.

10.2 Consent Management Framework

We implement a consent management mechanism aligned with GDPR and UK GDPR requirements, including:

- Granular consent options (by cookie category)
- Prior consent for non-essential cookies
- Ability to withdraw or modify consent at any time
- Logging and storage of consent records
- Geo-specific behaviour (EEA/UK vs other jurisdictions)

Where applicable, we align with IAB Transparency and Consent Framework (TCF) standards.

We maintain contractual agreements including:

- Data Processing Agreements (DPAs)
- Standard Contractual Clauses (where required)

10.5 Data Breach and Incident Response

We maintain procedures to:

- Detect and respond to data breaches.
- Notify regulators within required timelines.
- Inform affected individuals where required.

10.6 Data Protection by Design and Default

We implement data protection principles into system architecture, including:

- Data minimisation
- Access limitation
- Secure default settings
