1. Introduction

This Cookie Policy (“the Policy”) explains how Made4Capital Limited, trading as Made4Trading (the “Company”), uses cookies and similar technologies when users access or use the Company’s services.

2. What Are Cookies

Cookies are small text files or similar technologies stored on or accessed from your device to enable functionality, security, analytics and, where applicable, marketing activities.

3. Cookie Table

Below is a representative list of cookies and trackers the Company may use. Actual cookies may vary depending on your interaction with the Company’s services.

4. Third-Party Cookies

The Company may use third-party providers including:

- Analytics providers (For example, Google Analytics);
- Advertising platforms (For example, Meta, Google Ads);
- CRM and marketing automation tools;
- Trading platform providers.

These providers may process data in accordance with their own privacy policies.

5. Legal Basis (GDPR)

- **Strictly Necessary Cookies:** These cookies are necessary for the website to function properly and may be used without consent where permitted by applicable laws.
 - **Analytics, Functional, and Marketing Cookies:** These cookies are generally used only with the user's consent, where consent is required by applicable law.
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6. Managing Cookies

You can manage cookies via:

- Cookie consent banner
- Browser settings (For example, blocking or deleting cookies)

Please note that disabling certain cookies may impact the functionality of the services provided by the Company.

7. Retention

- Session cookies are deleted when you close your browser.
 - Persistent cookies remain on your device for the period specified in the table above, unless they are manually deleted earlier.
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8. Updates

The Company may update this Policy from time to time to reflect changes in technology, regulation, or its operations.

10. Data Protection Controls

10.1 Cookie & Tracker Inventory

In addition to the table above, the Company maintains an internal register of all cookies and tracking technologies deployed across:

- Website domains;
- Client portal;
- Trading platforms;
- Payment pages and Payment Service Provider integrations.

This inventory includes:

- Full technical identifiers;
- Data flows (collection → storage → transfer);
- Third-country transfer mapping;
- Vendor contracts and DPAs.

This register is reviewed periodically and updated upon any material change.

10.2 Consent Management

The Company has implemented a consent management mechanism aligned with GDPR requirements, including:

- Granular consent options (by cookie category);
 - Prior consent for non-essential cookies;
 - Ability to withdraw or modify consent at any time;
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- Logging and storage of consent records;
- Jurisdiction-specific cookie and consent settings, where applicable.

Where applicable, the Company aligns with IAB Transparency and Consent Framework (TCF) standards.

10.3 Data Processing Register

The Company maintains a record of processing activities, including the following:

Processing Activities	Client onboarding and KYC; Trading account management; Transaction processing; Risk monitoring and fraud detection; Marketing and analytics.
Data Categories	Identity data; Financial data; Technical data; Behavioural data.
Recipients	Regulators; Payment Service Providers; Liquidity providers; Technology vendors.
Transfers	Cross-border transfers, where applicable, documented with appropriate safeguards, such as Standard Contractual Clauses (SCCs) or the International Data Transfer Agreement (IDTA).

10.4 Subprocessor and Vendor Management

The Company conducts appropriate due diligence on relevant third-party providers, including:

- Data protection compliance;
- Security standards;
- Cross-border transfer mechanisms.

The Company maintains contractual agreements including:

- Data Processing Agreements (DPAs);
- Standard Contractual Clauses, where applicable.

10.5 Data Breach

The Company maintains procedures to:

- Detect and respond to data breaches;
- Assess and, where legally required, notify the relevant supervisory authority within the applicable statutory timeframe;
- Inform affected individuals where required.

10.6 Data Protection

The Company has implemented data protection principles into the system architecture, including:

- Data minimisation;
- Access limitation;
- Secure default settings.

10.7 Periodic Review

This Policy and associated frameworks are reviewed periodically to ensure ongoing compliance with:

- Mauritius Data Protection Act;
- GDPR;
- Applicable cookie and electronic communications requirements;
- Industry best practices.
